### Update on progress with Sallins Church Centenary Project.

Thank you for your patience with the church closure periods over the past two weeks which have been necessary in order to facilitate the continuing upgrade works. Work is progressing well!

The new decorative sanctuary doors have been installed. Significant painting has been carried out inside the church including painting the sanctuary, all the roof beams and the internal window frames, radiators and pipework. On the outside, the window frames, fascia and external doors have all been painted. It is planned to paint the perimeter walls and railings during the coming week.

Substantial progress has been made with necessary electrical and wiring improvements. In this regard, you may notice the new lighting in the sanctuary.

The next step in the upgrade is the installation of a new floor and carpet in the sanctuary area. This will take

two days and it will be necessary to close the church during that time for health and safety reasons.

The two days will be **Monday 10th and Tuesday 11th June**.

The church will re-open on Wednesday 12th June as normal.

Thank you for your understanding.

There are likely to be two more short periods of closure, dates not known yet. One of these periods will be to install the new altar furniture and the final period will be to lay a new carpet in the body of the church. When we have the dates, we will advise you and try to keep disruption to a minimum.






## The Altar Servers, St. Joseph's and St. Mary's Youth Groups...
