

St. Pio of Pietrelcina.... Padre Pio

This weekend during the 11am Mass in Our Lady and St. David's Church we will be blessing a statue of St. Pio of Pietrelcina. St. Pio better known as Padre Pio, he was canonized in 2002.

Padre Pio is a much-loved saint who instils in people a fervent and heartfelt devotion. Known for his powerful intercession and he was renowned as a confessor, hearing confessions for long periods of each day. He died on Sept. 23rd 1968, reportedly spending his last few moments in prayer.




