Confirmation Retreats, Legion of Mary and so much more...

Many have commented on his fine homilies, early signs are obvious of a fine preacher in the making!

In the final line from today's Second Reading from Hebrews we read

'Let us keep firm in the hope we profess, because the one who made the promise is faithful.'

Laurence, may you always trust God's faithful love.

And so, we thank you for your fine contribution to our three parishes, we were truly blessed to have you among us. We wish you every blessing in the coming weeks as you prepare for your ordination on Tuesday 24th June. You are a credit to yourself personally, your family and your diocese. No doubt our paths will cross again, you are always welcome in these parts.






Cemetery Masses
