and give me peace of mind.*

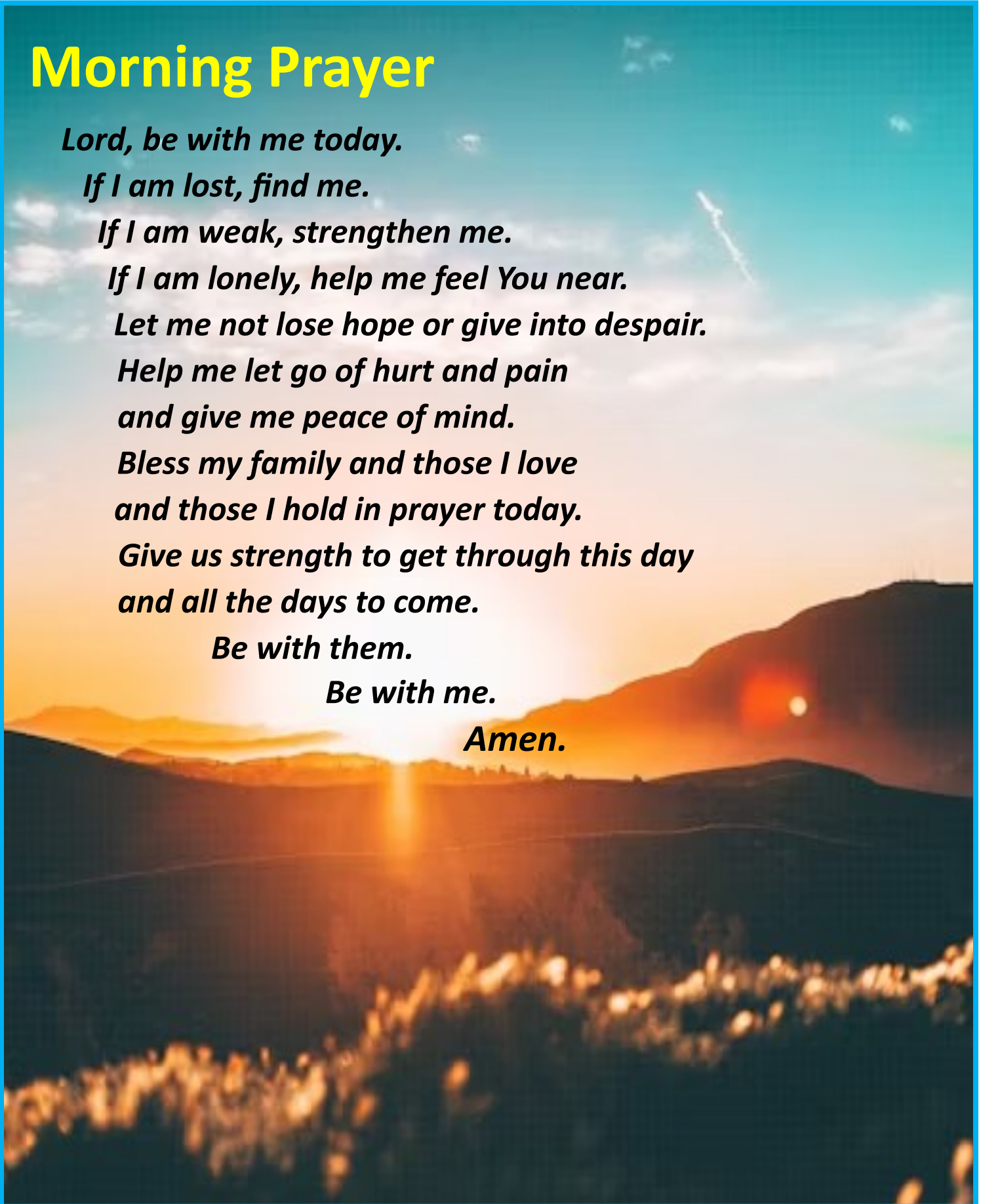
