A Message from Bishop Denis: Day of Prayer and Reflection for Gaza.

At the opening of the Jubilee of Youth in a packed St Peter's Square, Pope Leo XIV said: "We must cry out for peace in the world" and he then invited all the young people to join him in saying: "We want peace in the world!" In the words of Cardinal Pizzaballa, the Latin Patriarch of Jerusalem:

"Christ is not absent from Gaza. He is there, crucified in the wounded, buried under rubble and yet present in every act of mercy, every candle in the darkness, every hand extended to the suffering".

The images we are watching on nightly news bulletins and on social media feeds are appalling. Many ask what can we do? We can become numb in our sense of helplessness before scenes that speak of "man's inhumanity to man". We feel bewildered when we see and hear about people crushed by hunger or crushed in the stampede for airdropped food. Most upsetting of all is the horrible violence and death that children are experiencing and witnessing. Archbishop Eamon Martin has called on parishes to set aside **Sunday, 24th August** as a day of prayer and reflection for Gaza. I echo his call and ask all in Kildare & Leighlin to observe this day of

prayer. We can light a candle in our family home or local parish church; attend Mass, spend time before the Blessed Sacrament; pray the Rosary; make some small personal penance or sacrifice, and on that day

"let the light of hope radiate out from the island of Ireland for peace, for Gaza and for the future of its people."

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament will take place from 2pm - 5pm in Our Lady and St. David's Church on the main Altar on Sunday 24th August.

(They will qualify for HAP payments and our group will cover pre-arrival expenses.) There are many other preconditions, all of which our group can arrange, but accommodation is where we urgently need your help. Do you know of a property anywhere in Ireland that would accommodate this journalist and his family of four for a minimum of two years. Our group is well-resourced and motivated to make any property work. As a group, we have already been renting a property in Naas for the last 5 years and can therefore supply references from the property owner, neighbours and residents' association."


