Our Workshop Presenters



Gemma Mulligan is the Pastoral Coordinator for the Diocese of Ossory and a trained Godly Play storyteller. She integrates Godly Play into her pastoral work, particularly with children preparing for the sacraments, helping them to explore faith through story, wonder, and play.



Fr Robert Petrisor has served as curate in the Parishes of Naas, Sallins and Two Mile House since September 2020. Robert is a priest of the Archdiocese of Bucharest in Romania. He leads a vibrant ministry with the Liturgy Groups of the three parishes and has overseen the creation of many creative and beautiful Sacred Spaces marking the seasons and other special occasions.



Mary Connolly is a retired teacher with an MA in Liturgical Studies and a Diploma in Spiritual Direction. In her time as Resource Person for Liturgy in the Archdiocese of Tuam, she facilitated the liturgical formation of both laity and clergy alike and is a member of the Liturgy Association of Ireland.



Fr Peter O'Kane is a priest of the Diocese of Derry. He holds postgraduate degrees in Canon Law, Catechetical Sciences, Music, and Theology. He is presently responsible for Evangelisation and Adult Faith Formation in his home diocese, as well as adjunct lecturer in Saint Patrick's Pontifical University Maynooth and sessional lecturer at the Priory Institute Dublin.



Julie Kavanagh is the Pastoral Resource Person in the Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin. She holds an MA in Liturgical Studies from St John's University, Collegeville, Minnesota. She is Secretary to the Liturgy Association of Ireland and is a member of the Irish Bishops' Council for Liturgy and the National Synod Team.



Ian Callanan is a distinguished Irish liturgical composer. His works have been performed in numerous languages across Europe and featured in television and radio broadcasts. His music was sung during the Papal Mass in Ireland 2018. He is Chairperson of the Irish Church Music Association.
