‘They are not gone from us, but gone before us.’

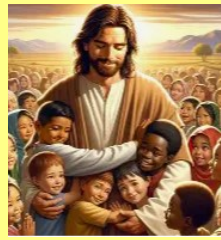

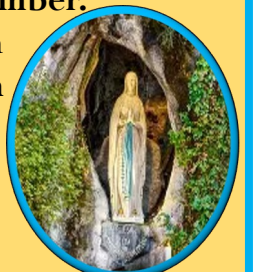
