To the Parishioners of Sallins,

Thank you very much to all our parishioners for the financial support which we continue to receive.

The 2024 income via the envelope collection this year was boosted by the once-off collection for the refurbishment works to the sanctuary and for that we are most grateful. In addition, we continue to receive strong rental income from the car parking area which also supports the upkeep of the church. Our main expense in 2024 was the church sanctuary refurbishment to celebrate our 100th anniversary and also legal and professional fees in relation to preparations for the ongoing sale of the plot of land to the rear of the parish community centre.

The Parish qualifies for the Charitable Donation Scheme and is entitled to reclaim tax at a rate of 45% on donations of more than €250 per year. To take advantage of this scheme, we must be able to record donations. We would therefore encourage you to donate in a way this can be achieved and the easiest way is through the weekly envelope boxes or via standing order. For more information on taking part in this scheme, please contact Sarah in the Parish Office or one of the members of our finance committee.

To the Parishioners of Two Mile House,

The members of the Parish Finance Committee thank you, most sincerely, for your contributions to the finances of the Parish. The summary statement above reflects income from collections, a significant tax refund and other income from candles and the purchase of graves. Spending in 2024 was in line with previous years across the areas as shown above.

The tax refund received in 2024 was based mainly on a claim under the Charitable Donation Scheme (€11,300), with a larger than usual refund under the VAT Compensation Scheme for Charities (€1,670) arising from the higher spending on maintenance in 2023.

We are very grateful for your participation in the Charitable Donation Scheme which contributes a significant amount to the Parish finances each year. Parishioners contributing either by the identified envelopes or by an identifiable online contribution can increase the value of their contribution by 45%, provided they have given their consent by completing a certificate. If anyone wishes to join the scheme, please contact any of the Committee members listed below.

Thank you again for your support to the Parish, both to the finances and also in the non-financial support provided by many of you who do a range of jobs from collecting, counting, church cleaning and many other jobs that are kindly done on a voluntary basis.
