"The Candle in the window"

A young girl and her brother lit a candle in the window each night while their grandad was in hospital. That small light became a symbol of their hope. Just before Christmas, their prayers were answered - Granda came home. The candle became more than a decoration - it was a quiet promise that love and healing were near. Even now, the memory of its glow reminds the family that hope can shine through the darkest nights. The prophets in the Bible waited and hoped for the coming of Jesus. Just like them, we light the first candle of Advent to remind us that hope is alive. This week, can you be a sign of hope for someone? Maybe write a kind note, say a prayer for someone who's sick, or light a candle at home and say, "Jesus I trust in you."


