We think of the words of Jesus himself speaking to our understandable fears, he reassures us with these words

'Do not let your hearts be troubled, trust in God still and trust in me.'

While St. Paul tells us 'eye has not seen, or ear heard what marvels God has in store for those who love him'. Death therefore is not a dark end but the beginning of a path of new light, of hope.


November Altar List of the Dead


