Sunday 25th January. **Sunday of the Word of God**

'He opened their minds to understand the scriptures', this is how Pope Francis began his letter, *Aperuit illis*, (meaning 'He opened to them') issued on the 30th September 2019. Pope Francis wished to emphasise the importance of God's Word in our lives: Reading, Reflecting and Understanding. As psalm 119 reminds us: "His word is a lamp for my feet". The Word of God that guides our journey through life.

On Sunday 25th January, **All Readers** in our three parishes (Ministers of God's Word) are invited to attend the Mass of their own choice. During the Mass, they will be invited to stand before the Sanctuary and receive a blessing, renewing their commitment to this important ministry as a Minister of the Word.

Secondly, **ALL Parishioners** are invited to bring their family Bible to Mass, and during the Mass, ALL Bibles will be blessed.

Sunday 1st February. **Feast of St Brigid**

Abbess, Secondary Patron of Ireland and Patron Saint of our Diocese of Kildare and Leighlin.

Monday 2nd February. **Presentation of the Lord.**

We continue the tradition of having Blessed Candles in our homes. Seeking the light of Christ, dispelling the darkness of sin. They symbolise the hope and triumph of light over darkness.

If you would like to have **candles blessed**, please place your candles in the basket provided near the Altar with your name clearly written and sellotaped onto the candles. They will be blessed during the 10am Mass on Monday the 2nd of February in the Parish Church.

(Please note that as Monday 2nd February is a Bank Holiday there will only be the 10am Mass on that day.)
