Training for New and Existing Parish Readers

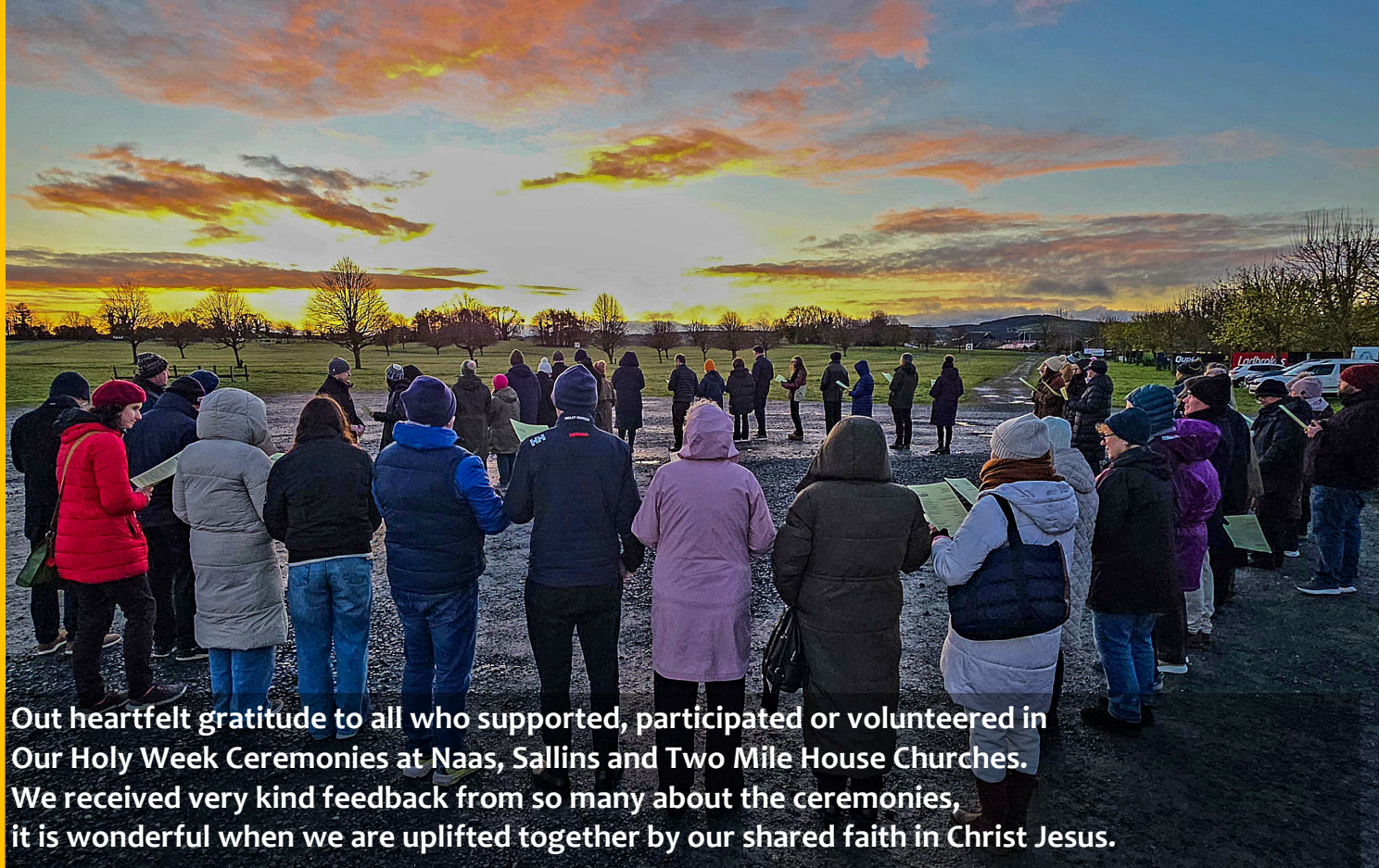
The Diocese is hosting a series of training sessions for parish Readers.

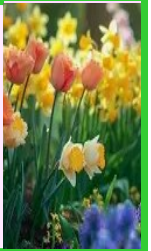
