They have shown wonderful dedication and commitment to the works which are progressing extremely well.

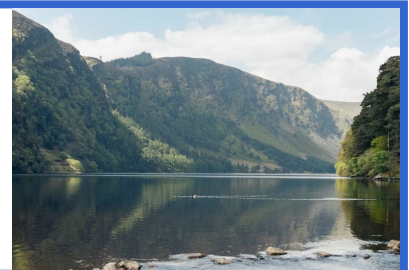
