A Small Change

The new Mass Schedule published during the month of July will take effect on the second weekend of October. For some parishioners it is not an insignificant change, particularly the parishioners of Sallins Parish and those parishioners in Naas who regularly attend the vigil Mass in Ballycane on Saturday evenings. Over time, we become accustomed to a particular Mass, it is often convenient and we like the presence of familiar faces.

Change isn't easy and I want to acknowledge that reality. I am most grateful to all affected for their kindness and understanding.

The underlying principle is the correct one, the need to work closely as neighbouring parishes and to support each other in practical ways. The New Mass Schedule offers us flexibility to cover all Masses in our clustered area which will be 12 weekend Masses in total.

Last Sunday I celebrated Mass in Sallins. Mindful of, and taking on board practical feedback; from the choir, Ministers of Holy Communion who bring Eucharist to Larchfield Nursing Home on Sundays, and of individual feedback. We have made a small adjustment! Sunday Mass in Sallins will now be celebrated commencing on the weekend of Sunday 8th October at 11.30am. 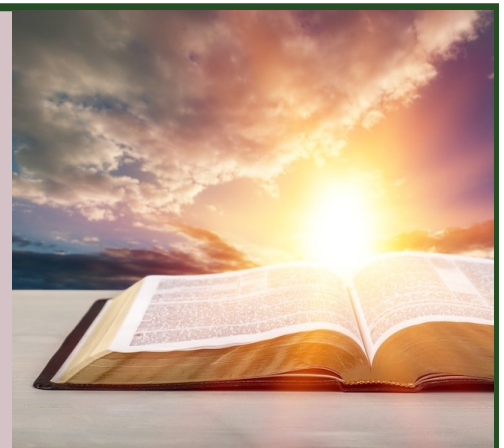
Are you interested in becoming a Young Reader?
